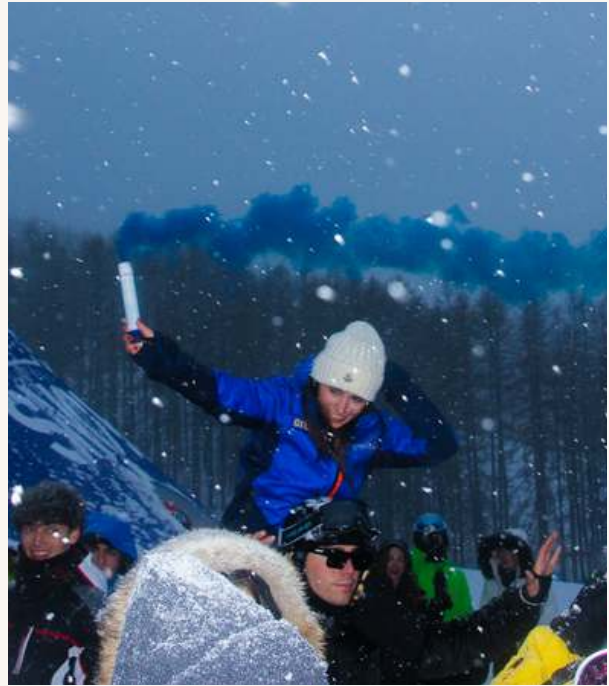

IMPROVING THE ITALIAN UNIVERSITY SYSTEM

Unilab Svoltastudenti is a national network of independent representative lists.

We aim to unite associations that share the idea of a representation free from the influences of political parties, movements and religious associations. We believe in peer2peer representation: made by students for students.

Born in 2013, we are a constant presence in the National Council of University Students, the main consultative body of the Ministry of University and Research: the only tool that students have to directly influence the decisions of the Ministry.

We advocate for a more inclusive university that champions the right to education, fosters innovation to stay current with the times, promotes meritocracy, internationalization, and ensures a high standard of quality.

To date, Unilab is a well-established presence across much of Italy, advancing requests and proposals gathered from across the country. In recent years, we have achieved significant progress in expanding the Right to Education, including extending and stabilizing the No Tax Area; and with the "voto fuori sede", which we will continue to fight for.

After seven years of efforts and three councils, we successfully introduced Double Enrollment, allowing students across Italy to enroll in two degree programs simultaneously. We also initiated I-Rasmus, an internal exchange program, launching this year as a pilot project between the University of Bergamo and Reggio Calabria. Furthermore, for the 2024 European elections, we secured the approval of voting rights for non-residents.

In essence, Unilab serves as a national extension of what B.lab represents within our university: a laboratory of ideas where diverse perspectives from across Italy converge to develop and advance proposals for a university that prioritizes students and their preparation for both the workforce and life in general. Most importantly, we are a group of friends united by a common vision.

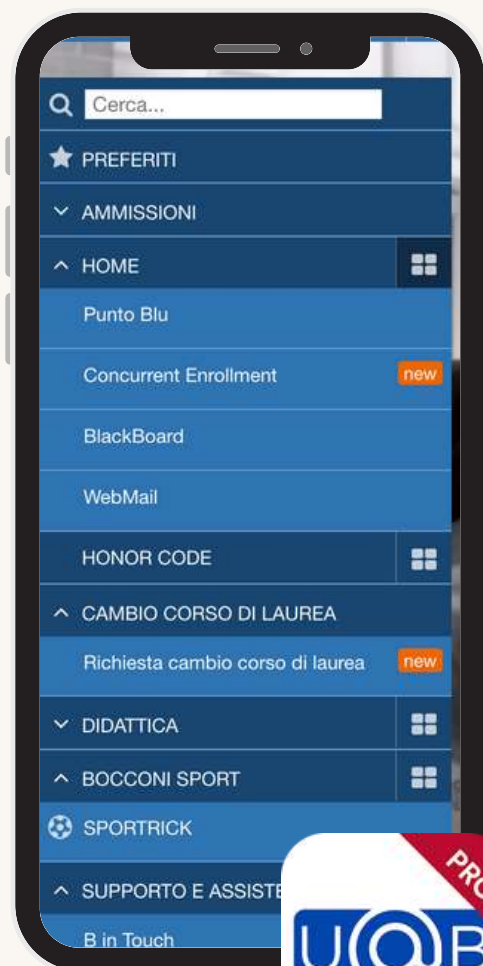

As a crucial tool, it is important to familiarize yourself with all of its features in order to make the most of the resources offered by the university.

All the most important communications from Bocconi will arrive in this box.

BLUE POINT

YoU@B is the portal where you can check the payment of academic fees and view, and possibly modify, the study plan. In addition, you can consult the grades of the exams already taken.

OUTLOOK

Every Bocconi student has a university email address. You can access your email through YoU@B ("WebMail" section) or directly through Outlook, both in website mode and via the app.

Using this email regularly is important to stay in touch with the university and receive all official communications.

BLACKBOARD

Bocconi's e-learning platform, known as Blackboard, contains virtually all of your courses. Here, professors will upload slides, teaching materials, and course outlines, including the syllabus, which is the main document for each course and contains all the details and guidelines for the exam.

LESSONS AND ATTENDANCE...

ATTENDANCE?

This is probably one of the most frequent words you will hear in class in the first few days, but what is it? Where does it go? How does it work? Here's a quick explanation...

Some classes require mandatory attendance and you need to know how to be sure to mark your presence, the so-called "attendance".

There are two different ways: on the "Blackboard" website by clicking on the page relating to the subject of the hour and then on "Attendance"/"Register your presence"; the other, simpler way is on the you@b app and by clicking on the lesson time it will be possible to conveniently register your presence.

It is good to remember every time you enter the classroom, when the professor arrives, to register so as to always have the habit and not forget in case the lesson is mandatory.

Warning: some exams are different for "attending" and "non-attending" students, do not register your presence if you are not sure you will not remain in the classroom as the University carries out checks!

Avoid unpleasant surprises...

BADGE ?

The magnetic card (Bocconi ID card) is essential for student identification as it is useful for entering the Library and the Bunker.

You can book for collection in the first few days after your arrival and, in case of loss, you can request a new one.

The "badge" will not be used for lessons but will be important when you take exams as it will be requested at the time of recognition.

PS: don't worry about the photo... it's a common problem!

Is it true that at Bocconi you can't refuse grades?

The answer is yes, once you get your vote you cannot replace it.

REGISTRATIONS



To take any exam you will take at Bocconi University, registration is required, without which you will not be admitted to the test in any way. Registration opens before each exam session (well in advance) and my advice is to register as soon as possible to avoid the mistake of forgetting.


The exams may be of different types depending on the subject: partial, general or oral.

VOTES


Once the exam has been taken, the evaluation will appear on you@b, i.e. a maximum score of 31 (30 with honours).

The minimum score to pass the exam is 18/31 and once you have reached this score, be careful, it is not possible to refuse or it is not possible to take a further test.


It is possible, if dissatisfied with the test during its execution, to "withdraw" or to hand in an assignment that will not be corrected and therefore not evaluated and to take a new test in the next session.



VIEW ASSIGNMENTS & RECEPTIONS



Reviewing assignments after exams: this moment is important because it allows you to receive direct feedback on your mistakes and understand how to improve. Reviewing assignments can happen individually or through a meeting organized by the teacher. Office hours with teachers: Students are encouraged to book appointments with teachers to clarify any doubts or to delve deeper into certain topics.

DEADLINES

For a university student, it is necessary to respect deadlines.

1. Fee: to be paid with MAV or PagoPa via Punto Blu and be careful because every day in Rotardo there is a penalty to pay!
2. Year: to pass the first year (Bachelor's Degree and Law) you will have to obtain 24 credits by the July session, i.e. the September session is excluded.

CFU?

CFU (university training credit) is a method used in Italian universities to measure the workload required of a student to obtain a degree.

Each exam you will have to take has its own corresponding number of CFU and this allows you to understand how much an exam "weighs" on the total average.

The CFU are awarded in full regardless of the grade obtained (e.g.: microeconomics 9 CFU, if you pass the exam you will have +9 in the calculation).

HOW IS THE AVERAGE CALCULATED?

There are two different types of media that we will illustrate with numerical examples:

WEIGHTED AVERAGE

- 30 in Business Economics (10 CFU)
- 28th Microeconomics (9 CFU)
- 24th General Mathematics (8 CFU)

$$(30 \cdot 10 + 28 \cdot 9 + 24 \cdot 8) / (10 + 9 + 8) = 27,55$$

MEDIA WITH MODULES

- 30 Microeconomics (9 CFU)
- 28 a Macroeconomia (8 CFU)

- TOT. CFU = 17
- AVERAGE RATING = 29

This module will have a weight of 17 and a score of 29



ICDL

WHAT IS ICDL?

The ICDL Full standard is a computer science certification required for the second partial of the Computer Science exam (6 CFU) for the following degree courses: CLEAM, CLEF, BIEM, BIEF, BIG, CLEACC, BEMACC and BESS. For the courses CLMG and BGL, however, the ECDL is necessary to be able to take the computer science exam (3 CFU) in the second year.

7 MODULES TO COMPLETE

MODE

Each module consists of 36 questions, to pass the module you must get a score equal to or higher than 75% in 45 minutes.

The exams will take place in room 304 (3rd floor of the Library).

HOW TO REGISTER?

Buy the skill card (cost: 60 euros) and each individual exam (cost: 18 euros per exam) on you@b in the "IT certifications" widget.

The skill card will have a unique code that will arrive on the Outlook email you entered.

Choose the day and time and start whenever you want!

LANGUAGE CERTIFICATIONS

To assess linguistic knowledge, the student can choose between:

1. passing the internal Bocconi exam
2. Acquisition of an international certification among those recognized by the University: the certification must be verifiable online and must be of a level equal to or higher than that required

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The request must be submitted within 3 years of taking the certification exam (2 years for TOEFL and IELTS).

The score obtained on the certification exam is then converted into a grade for the language exam in question.

RECOGNITION PROCEDURE

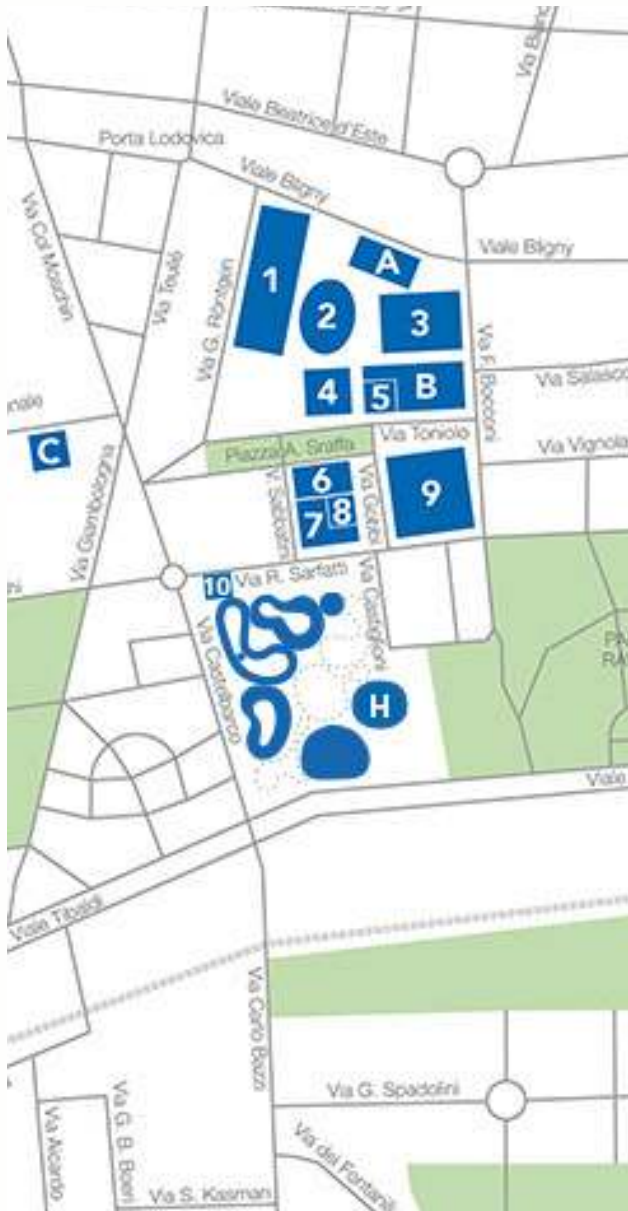

1 - ROETGEN

The new headquarters of the University immediately attracts attention with its spectacular glass and square shapes in gray granite that do not go unnoticed. Here are the offices of the Bocconi professors, accessible only with ID or QR code, and the Aula Magna, where the Rector welcomes the freshmen. But the real highlight is the GUD bar, famous for its unusual karaoke nights and epic ping pong challenges to the death.

2- DEL VECCHIO BUILDING (EX VELODROMO)

Nicknamed for a long time "Velodromo" for its elliptical shape, this building is, together with the Lions, the beating heart of lessons and exams for Bocconi students. The classrooms, arranged on three floors plus the ground floor, have names that seem like secret codes: an N followed by the floor number (0, 1, 2 or 3) and the classroom number (type N32). Between lessons, students can relax on the tables and chairs arranged outside the classrooms or take advantage of the strategically placed printers.

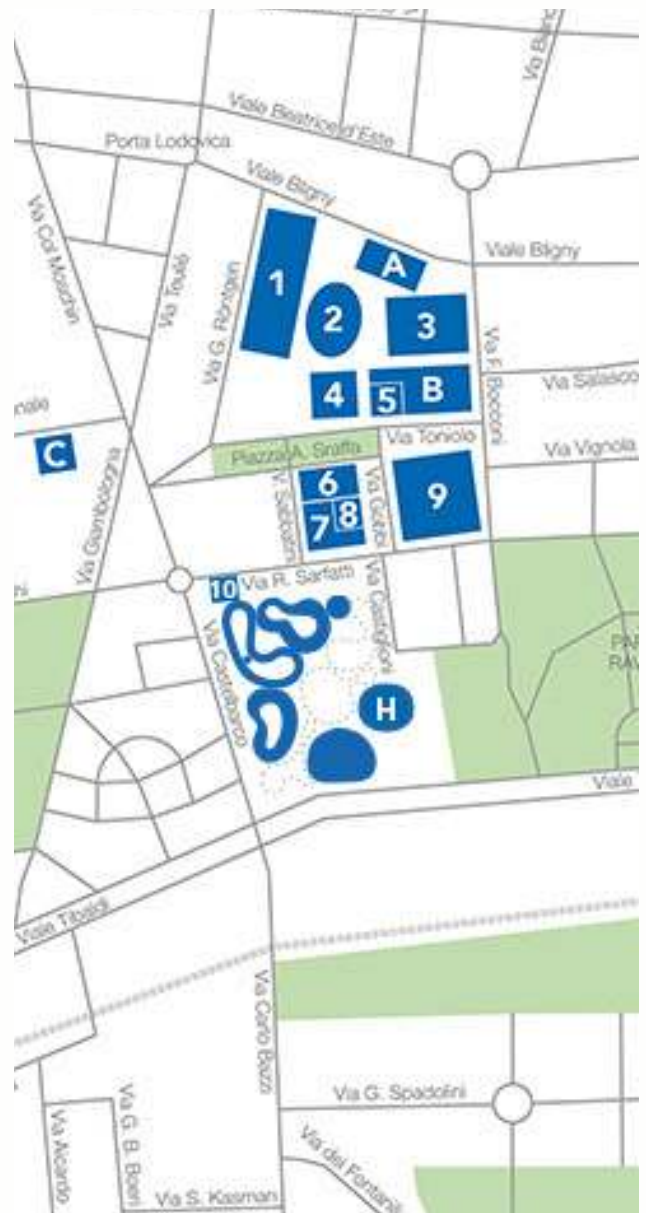


B - BOCCONI RESIDENCE "THE PENSIONATO"

Located in the heart of the campus and with the same style as the Leoni, the Bocconi residence, affectionately known as "Pensionato", is one of the most characteristic places of the University. With a cafeteria that is always crowded, a five-a-side football pitch and a lively Media Center, here you will never get bored. Just one piece of advice: watch out for the doors, which often act up!

6 - BUNKER

With its hidden entrance to the side of the Biblio, this underground space is one of the most popular places for Bocconi students. Born as a study area, it is actually perfect for making new friends, organizing trips or working in groups, rather than for the crazy and desperate studying that the session often requires. Like the Biblio, here too you need a badge or QR code to enter.

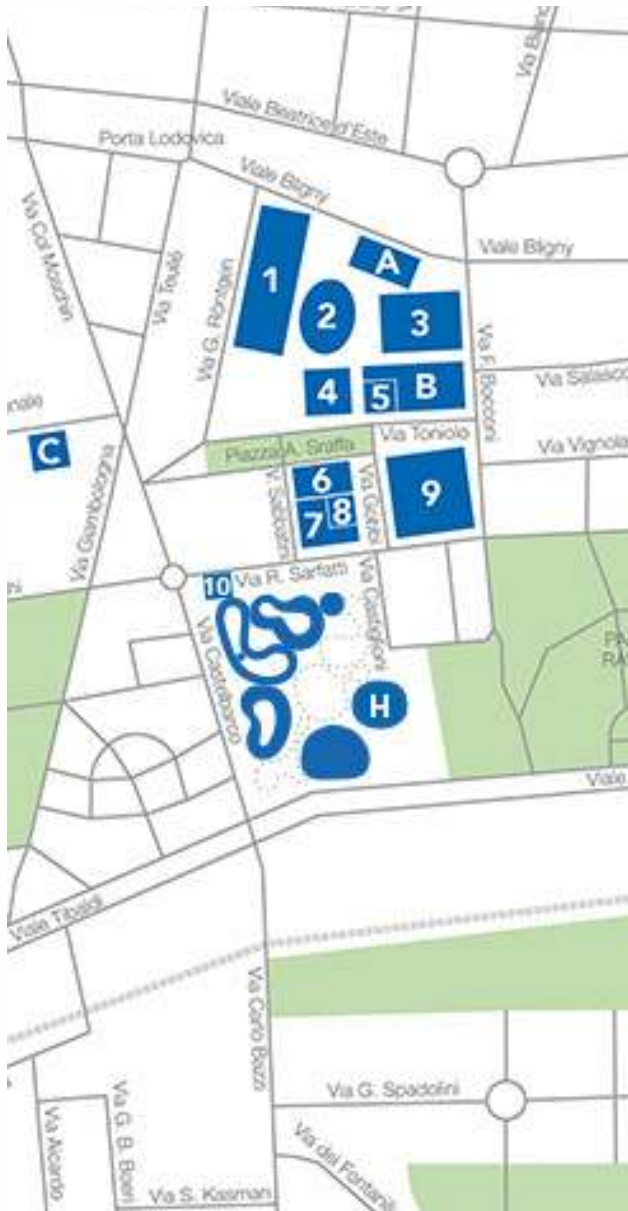


7 - LIBRARY

Located next to the Leoni, this is the mecca for Bocconians in session: a place of frenetic but silent activity, where people fight to grab a seat... especially when exams are looming! The building also houses the IT Center, where you can take ICDL exams, and the Aula Magna Gobbi. And don't forget, entry is reserved for those with a Bocconi badge or QR code ready to use!

9 - LEONI

It is the oldest building on campus, so much so that its address is still the official one of the University. However, everyone calls it "The Lions", thanks to the two funny green lion statues that guard the entrance. Legend has it that if you try to pass between them before graduation, you will never finish your studies! The Lions' classrooms are marked with numbers or the names of historical figures linked to the University. Inside, in addition to the classrooms, there are also study stations and the Representatives' Hall, the headquarters of the most active student associations.



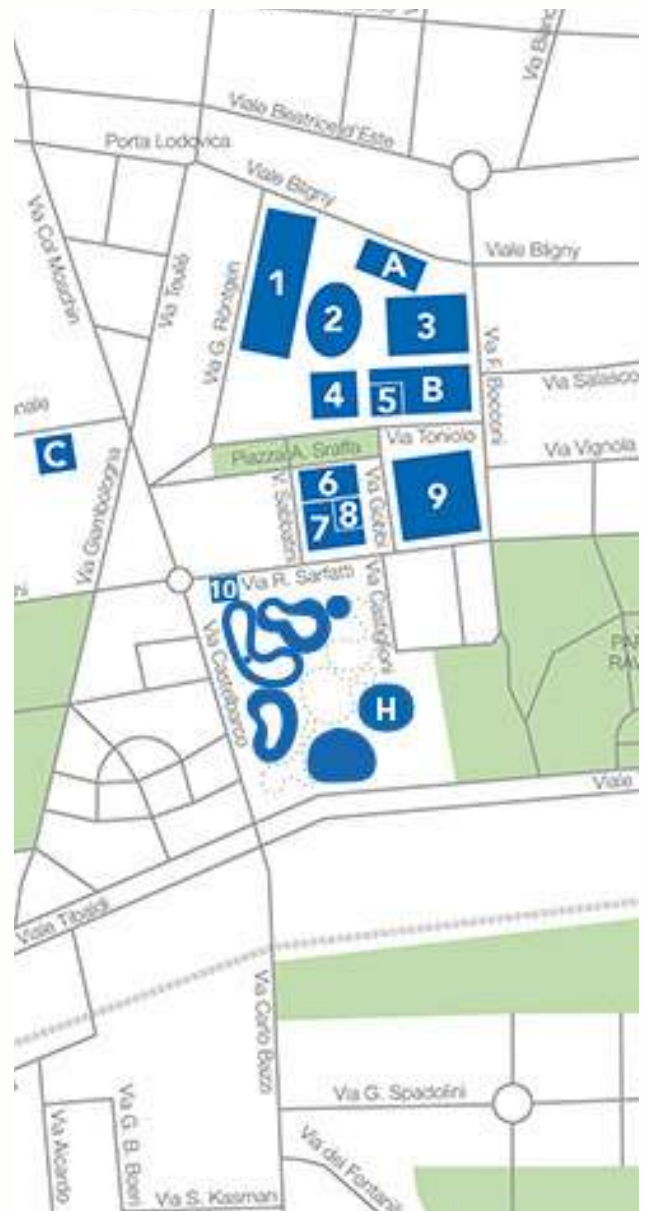

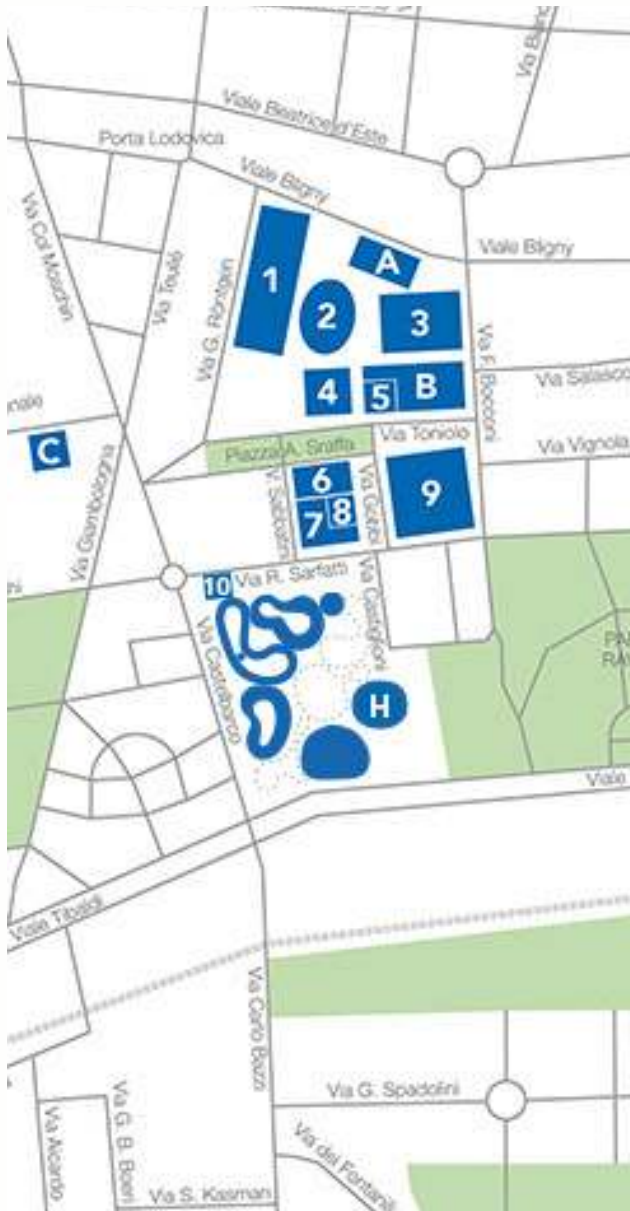


A - BLIGNY RESIDENCE

LIBRARY

Imagine this: there are study areas that are divided into two types, the quiet common areas (where absolute silence reigns) and the livelier classrooms. 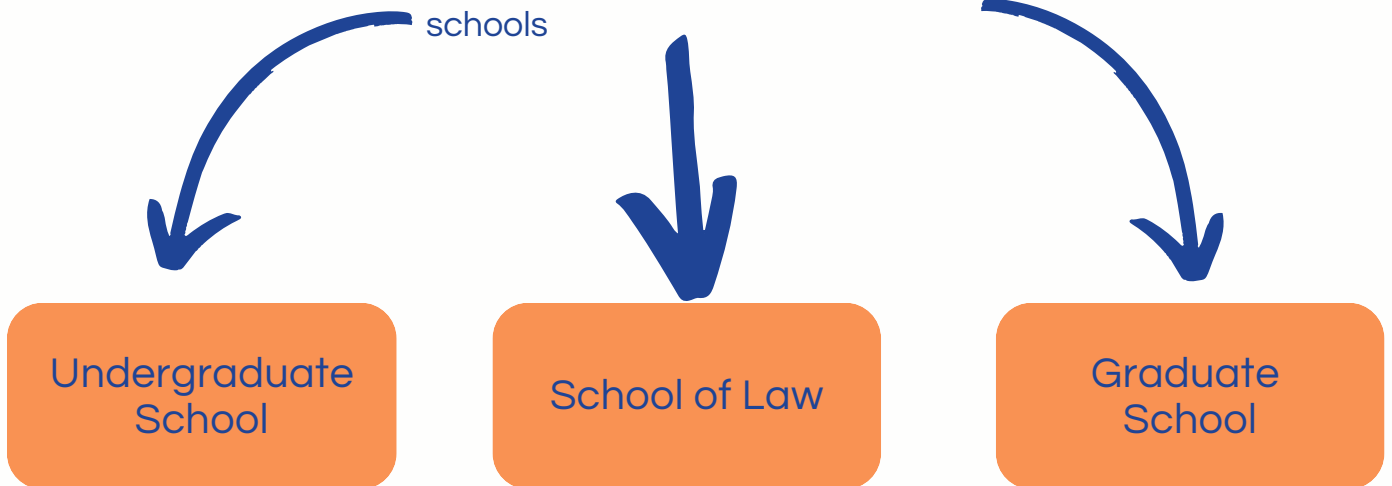

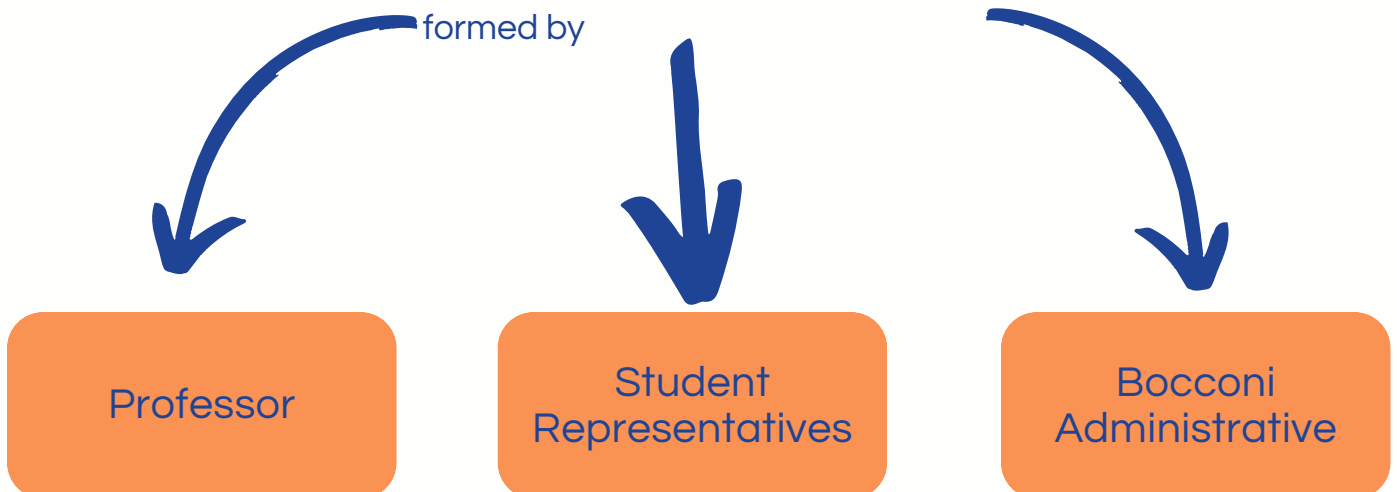

If you have decided to embark on a three-year degree program, congratulations! You are officially a member of the Three-Year School. In these three years, you will immerse yourself in the essential foundations to then tackle the master's degree. The university will offer you an avalanche of opportunities, from curricular internships to exchange experiences abroad in the third year. The exam calendar? Get ready: it starts in September and ends in June, with four sessions well distributed between October, December, March and June. A real tour de force! After the Bachelor, the possibilities are endless! The Scuola Biennale offers Masters and Master of Science (MSc) in areas such as management, economics, finance, data science and political science, mostly in English. You can further specialize or change fields entirely. The first year will be tougher, while the second year offers you more freedom with elective courses, internships and study abroad opportunities.

For those aiming for Law, there are the CLMG and BGL courses, highly international with many lessons in English. Add practical experiences such as legal clinics, moot courts and internships, and you will be ready for the world of work!

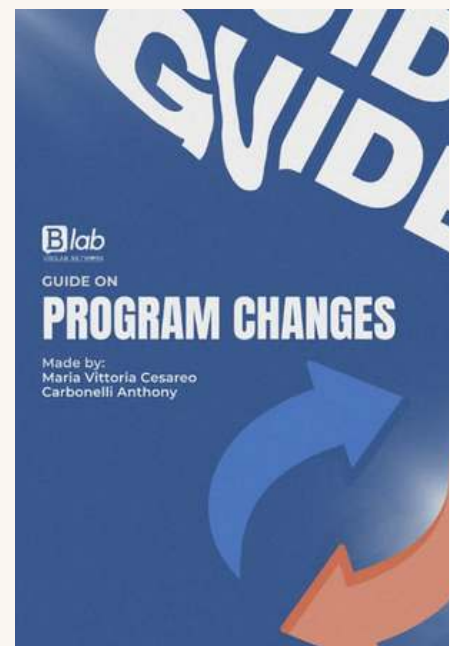
CHANGE OF COURSE

The rules regarding changes in degree courses take into account two fundamental criteria: the language of teaching and whether or not the degree belongs to the common basis.

In the case of transferring to a course taught in the same language, it will be possible to apply at the end of the first, second or third year of the course, while, if the teaching language is different, it will be possible to apply only at the end of the first year of the course (e.g. from CLEAM to BIEM).

The application must be submitted via the yoU@B agenda, expressing a preference for a maximum of two degree courses and it will be necessary to be enrolled in the following academic year of the original course.

In case of transfer to degree courses taught in English, it will be necessary to have a C1 level certificate or to have taken the internal English exam at B2 level with a minimum grade of 26/30.



TO KNOW MORE...

Due to numerical constraints related to class size, students are selected through a merit-based ranking, determined on the basis of the average grades obtained in exams, weighted by the credits obtained.

Furthermore, it will be possible to change courses only once within the same academic year.



ISU AND CONCESSIONS

It is known that Bocconi, being a private university, involves high costs that may be difficult for many families to sustain. However, the University offers a series of concessions and full and partial scholarships, to allow anyone to become a Bocconian. Let's see together what we are talking about!

ISU SCHOLARSHIP

The ISU scholarship includes elements that are always available and others that can be obtained based on a ranking among the scholarship applicants.

ITEMS ALWAYS AVAILABLE:

- Total exemption from university taxes and fees;
- Access to the canteen service at a reduced rate (valid from December 2025 to November 2026) and provision of free meal vouchers for a value of €818;
- Possibility of carrying out paid part-time work for a total of 200 hours;

OBTAINABLE ITEMS:

- Cash benefit equal to half of the scholarship available for students who graduate within the course of study and students participating in exchange programs, Double/Joint Degree, CEMS-MIM or internships carried out outside Italy free of charge;
- Accommodation in a reduced-rate residence (it has the same requirements as the ISU scholarship but requires a separate application)



THE REQUIREMENTS TO OBTAIN IT

INCOME REQUIREMENTS

- ISEE NOT EXCEEDING 26,306.25 EUROS
- ISPE NOT EXCEEDING 57,187.53 EUROS

You understood correctly: anyone who meets the aforementioned economic requirements will be considered "eligible" and will obtain 100% of the elements previously defined as "always present". A ranking will then be drawn up based on income which will define who, among those who are considered eligible, can be defined as a "beneficiary"

MERIT REQUIREMENTS

The merit requirements, however, will be verified a posteriori, that is, after the benefit has been awarded; in particular, for the first year of the three-year degree and Law, to confirm the benefit, 44 credits must be achieved by 10 August 2026. To confirm the benefit for the second year, it will be necessary to have 49 credits (with the possibility of achieving them through 5 bonus credits).

ATTENTION: THE CONTRIBUTION IS NOT AUTOMATICALLY CONFIRMED FOR SUBSEQUENT ACADEMIC YEARS BUT MUST BE REQUESTED BY THE STUDENT EACH YEAR.



A POSSIBLE CHOICE

CAN BE RECEIVED BY STUDENTS:

- Residents in Italy with family unit resident in Italy;
- Coming from contexts of serious economic-social hardship;
- Who have submitted the single application "Bocconi4access to Education academic year 2025-26"

Students with a University ISEE lower than €30,000 will be given priority

As regards the application, the student must also send a MOTIVATION LETTER in which he/she describes in detail the reasons for the serious economic-social hardship to the Fees, Funding and Housing Office.

To renew the benefit, it will be necessary to be registered for the following year and have achieved a minimum of 30 credits by September 10, 2026, without the possibility of obtaining bonus credits.

GIVES RIGHTS TO:

- 100% exemption from the payment of university fees and contributions;
- Scholarship of 7000 euros (to be taxed at source);
- Possibility to obtain, upon request, meals at a discounted rate (subject to ISEE verification) and free accommodation in a double room at a Bocconi-affiliated residence



100% FULL TUITION WAIVERS

CAN BE RECEIVED BY STUDENTS:

-Enrolled in the first year of a three-year degree course or law course;

-Residents in Italy with family unit resident in Italy;
-coming from contexts of serious economic-social hardship;

-Who have submitted the single application "Bocconi4access to Education academic year 2025-26

Students with a University ISEE lower than €30,000 will be given priority

GIVES RIGHT TO:

To the total exemption from the payment of university fees and contributions

To CONFIRM the benefit for the second year it will be necessary to have achieved a minimum of 49 CFU by 10 September 2026



80-60 % PARTIAL TUITION WAIVERS

Benefits that entitle to exemptions of 80 and 60% from the ordinary Bocconi contribution. It requires the same enrollment and confirmation requirements as the 100% full tuition waiver benefit (respectively being resident in Italy and guaranteeing 49 credits by September) but this time priority will be given to students with a University ISEE lower than 50,000 euros.

40-20 % PARTIAL TUITION WAIVERS

These benefits guarantee exemption of 40% and 20% from the ordinary Bocconi contribution and, for their awarding, priority will be given to students who present a University ISEE greater than 50,000 euros and less than 100,000 euros, with an ISPE less than 200,000 euros. The criteria for enrolling and confirming the benefit are the same as those required for the exemptions previously discussed.



WOMEN AWARD

Bocconi University believes that GENDER EQUALITY should always be supported, starting from the moment of studies. For this reason, with the creation of this benefit it has decided to support women who want to undertake a career in fields of study often considered to be predominantly male choices

CAN BE RECEIVED BY:

The benefit does not have to be explicitly requested, but will be assigned at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Commission, giving priority to deserving students who have also demonstrated financial need through the online application "Bocconi4Access to Education a.a. 2025-2026".

GIVES RIGHT TO:

To the total exemption from the payment of university fees and contributions

To CONFIRM the benefit for the second year it will be necessary to have achieved a minimum of 49 CFU by 10 September 2026

ATTENTION: Students must be enrolled in the first year of the BIEF, BEMACS, BAI, BESS degree courses



PARTIAL EXEMPTIONS FOR BROTHERS/SISTERS ENROLLED AT THE SAME TIME

This benefit entails a 20% reduction in the ordinary contribution if a student has a brother/sister simultaneously enrolled at Bocconi in the same academic year. Obviously, it is required that the recipients of the benefit are regularly enrolled in the first year of a degree program in the 2025/26 academic year and are not recipients of other Bocconi benefits.

EXEMPTIONS FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES OR HANDICAPS

Bocconi University provides for students enrolled in the first year of a Bachelor's or Master's degree program in Law a 100% exemption from the ordinary Bocconi tuition fee in the event of a recognized handicap or with a disability equal to or greater than 66%.

ATTENTION: the benefit is not automatically confirmed for subsequent academic years, but there are no merit requirements to confirm the benefit.

The benefit of the exemption is granted for a maximum period not exceeding three semesters beyond the legal duration of the course of study attended, i.e. a maximum of nine semesters for three-year degree courses and a maximum of thirteen semesters for the law course.



MOVING TO MILAN

CAN BE RECEIVED BY STUDENTS:

-Enrolled in the first year of a three-year degree course or law course;

-Residents in Italy and NON-RESIDENTS IN MILAN

-Who have submitted the single application "Bocconi4access to Education academic year 2025-26

Students with a University ISEE lower than €50,000 will be given priority

ATTENTION: The benefit awarded may be renewed for a maximum of 4 years for undergraduate courses and 6 years for law.

To renew it for the 2025/26 academic year, regular enrollment in the academic year and achievement of a minimum of 49 credits by September 10, 2025 will be required.

GIVES RIGHT TO:

-Exemption between 100% and 60% from the payment of tuition and university fees and contributions;

-Accommodation at a reduced rate (€200 per month) in a Bocconi-affiliated residence

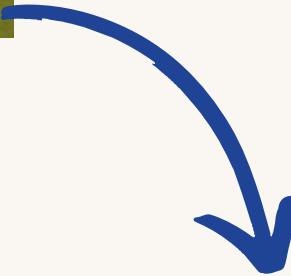

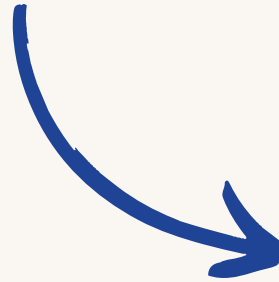

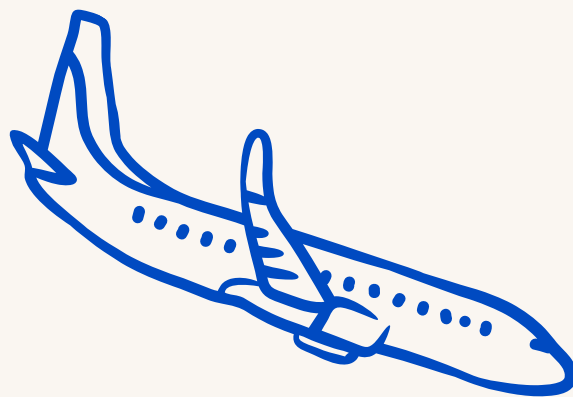

EXPERIENCES ABROAD

You should always keep in mind that your experience at Bocconi can go far beyond the borders of Milan.

Thanks to our University's tightly-supported international network, there are many opportunities to study abroad. So before you know it, you could be strolling the bustling streets of Manhattan, ready to party in cool clubs overlooking the Empire State Building. Or you could be walking down Las Ramblas in Barcelona, eating croissants in Paris, and immersing yourself in cultures very different from your own, creating unforgettable memories that will stay with you for a lifetime.



EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The Exchange Program is one of the main opportunities offered to live an experience outside of Bocconi University. If you are enrolled in a Bachelor's program, you can participate in this program during the third year, while for Law the opportunity is available during the fourth or fifth year, at your choice.

By participating in this program, you will have the opportunity to spend a semester in one of the partner universities, taking courses that will then be recognized in your study plan. For European destinations, the program is part of Erasmus, but you have access to well over 250 destinations worldwide.

TIPS:

- The application to participate must be submitted during the second year for three-year courses and halfway through the third year for Law.
- If you want to go to one of the most popular destinations, it is important to follow all the lessons carefully, prepare well for the exams and have a good average, but do not worry about this, there are really many destinations!
- Some destinations may have specific language requirements, such as an IELTS certificate, so it is essential to check these requirements well in advance to avoid any last-minute surprises.
- Ask the older kids for advice so you don't arrive unprepared!



AND MUCH MORE...

MASTER'S DEGREE

The opportunities do not end here! During the Master's Degree, you will have the opportunity to participate in the Exchange Program again.

Additionally, you can join a Double Degree program, which allows you to spend a full year at one of the prestigious partner universities and obtain an additional degree from that university, in addition to the one from Bocconi.

SPECIFIC PROGRAMS

There are also specific programs that include a study period abroad, such as CEMS, Double Degrees with Sciences Po - Bocconi and LSE - Bocconi, Double Degree with ESSEC - Bocconi, China MiM and Themis. These programs offer unique international experiences and will further enrich your academic and professional path.

IMPORTANT:

Please note that, except for BIG (International Politics and Government) students, participation in these programs is not mandatory.

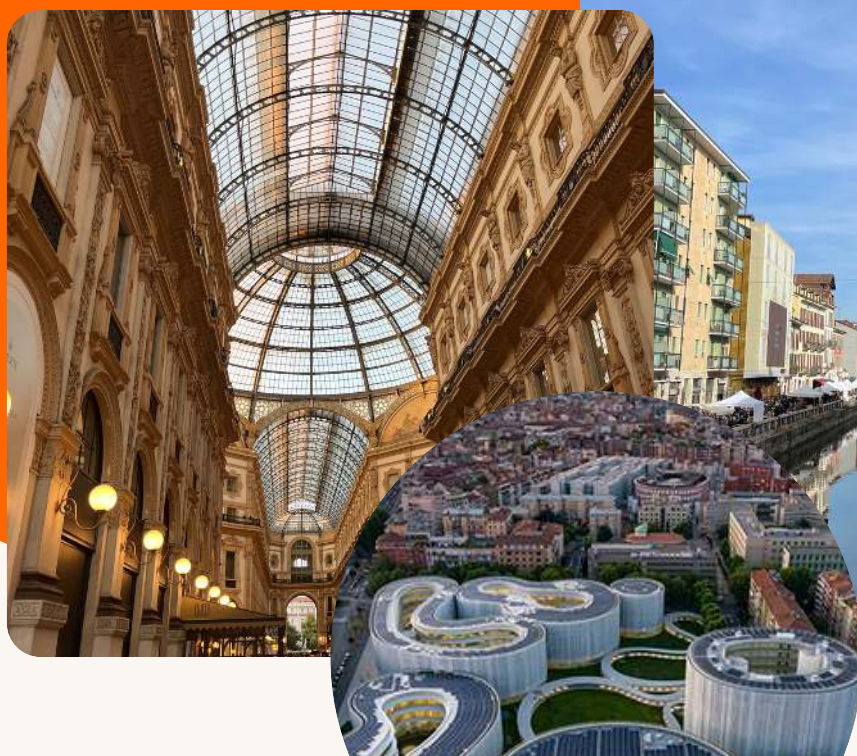


MILAN BY DAY...

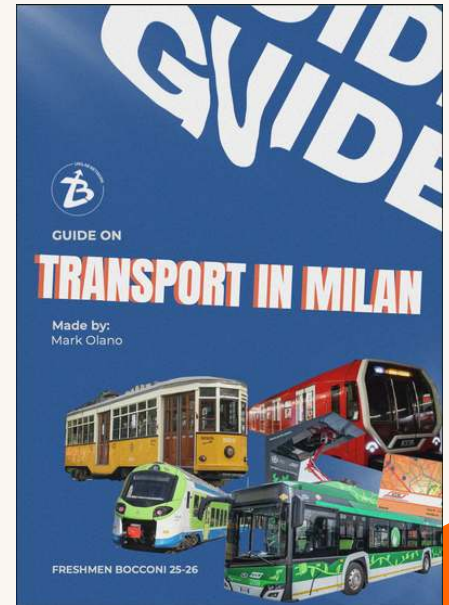


THE CITY OF MILAN

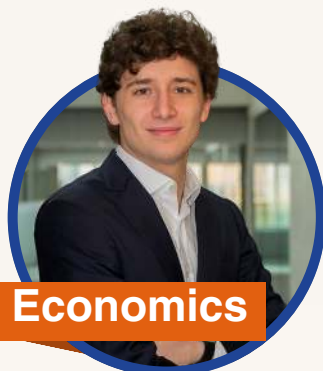
